

## ISO 45001:2018 IRCA Lead Auditor Training Course

### Duration:

Five days

### Objective

The new international health and safety standard ISO 45001:2018 was published in March 2018 and organisations have three years to migrate from the old OHSAS 18001:2007 system.

Learn how to lead an audit to this new health & safety standard ISO 45001. ISO 45001:2018 is the first international standard addressing the requirements for Occupational Health and Safety Management Systems. It follows on from the successful British Standard OHSAS18001, with updates including adoption of the Annex SL High Level Structure (already noted in standards such as ISO 9001 and ISO 14001).

This FIVE-DAY course provides an understanding and knowledge of auditing health and safety management systems to third party standards. You learn to build on the skills of how to plan, structure and conduct an effective audit and to evaluate and communicate the findings. The course is designed to follow the stages in a live audit, including simulated audit interviews and role play.

### Contents

This highly participative course is a practically based series of sessions using tutorials, case studies, interactive workshops and open forum discussions culminating with an examination. The practical emphasis of the course and the high tutor to attendee contact hours provide a unique opportunity for a substantial degree of individual guidance and training. ### Who should attend

Those responsible for obtaining certification e.g. ISO 45001:2018 or who wish to register as an IRCA OHS MS auditor (additional requirements also apply). Auditors who want to audit OH&S management systems and who need to show professional competence in this subject. Those new to auditing wishing to understand OH&S MS auditing or senior managers involved in the outcome of OH&S audits.

The ability to assess compliance of an organization to meet your own internal or external, eg. Certification body, requirements

The ability to develop an internal audit process to support your OH&S policy

Attendees' audits can be supervised to give practical on-site training. You will sit a 2 hour exam on day five to test your knowledge and your skills will be continually assessed throughout the programme. You must succeed in both elements to pass the course.

### **Certificates**

The course has been certified by the UK International Register of Certificated Auditors (IRCA) in partnership with SEQM (ref: 1958) and fulfils the IRCA training requirements for registration as a 3rd-party OHS management systems auditor. There is an examination on the last day, and a certificate will be issued on successful completion of the course.
